# EM20X - Double-pole emergency door release

### Product Description

The range of emergency door releases (EDR's) from CDVI provide a physical method of unlocking an electronic lock in the event of an emergency.

They are generally fitted where there is no manual method to permanently release fail safe locks by removing the power when the EDR is activated.

The EM201 is resettable. Pressing the front causes the plate to drop, triggering the micro switch. The plate remains dropped until it is reset by means of a key.

The EM200 can only be reset by replacing the plexi-glass once used.

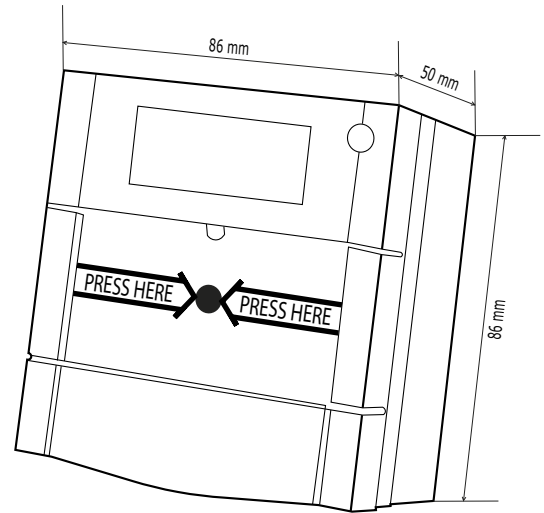
